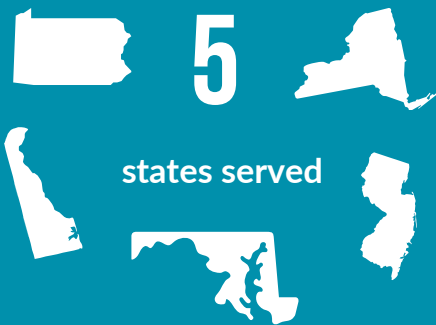

### OUR MISSION

For Pete's Sake Cancer Respite Foundation enables adult cancer patients and their loved ones to strengthen, deepen and unify their relationships by creating unforgettable and lasting Respite Experiences.

Collaborating with leading cancer centers, we offer cost-free retreats at Woodloch Resort for patients aged 21 to 55, their caregivers, and children.

FPS also offers support for patients who are too ill to travel through our **Staycation Respite** option. Additionally, we address their ongoing needs with our **Respite Reinforced Program**, which provides personalized assistance following the respite period.

### IN ACTION



Kathlene, age 36, is a single mother facing breast cancer. Despite financial challenges and restarting treatment due to medical complications, she's remained resilient and positive. But even the strongest families need time to pause and heal. Knowing this, her nominator at Doylestown Hospital saw the deep need for a break—an opportunity for Kathlene and her children to reconnect and recharge.

*"For me and my kids, it was a moment to reconnect and have fun which is something we hadn't done together in a long time. Feeling the sun on my face after spending most of the past year indoors was priceless. Even my oldest found healing by letting go of stress, praying together and walking by the lake.*

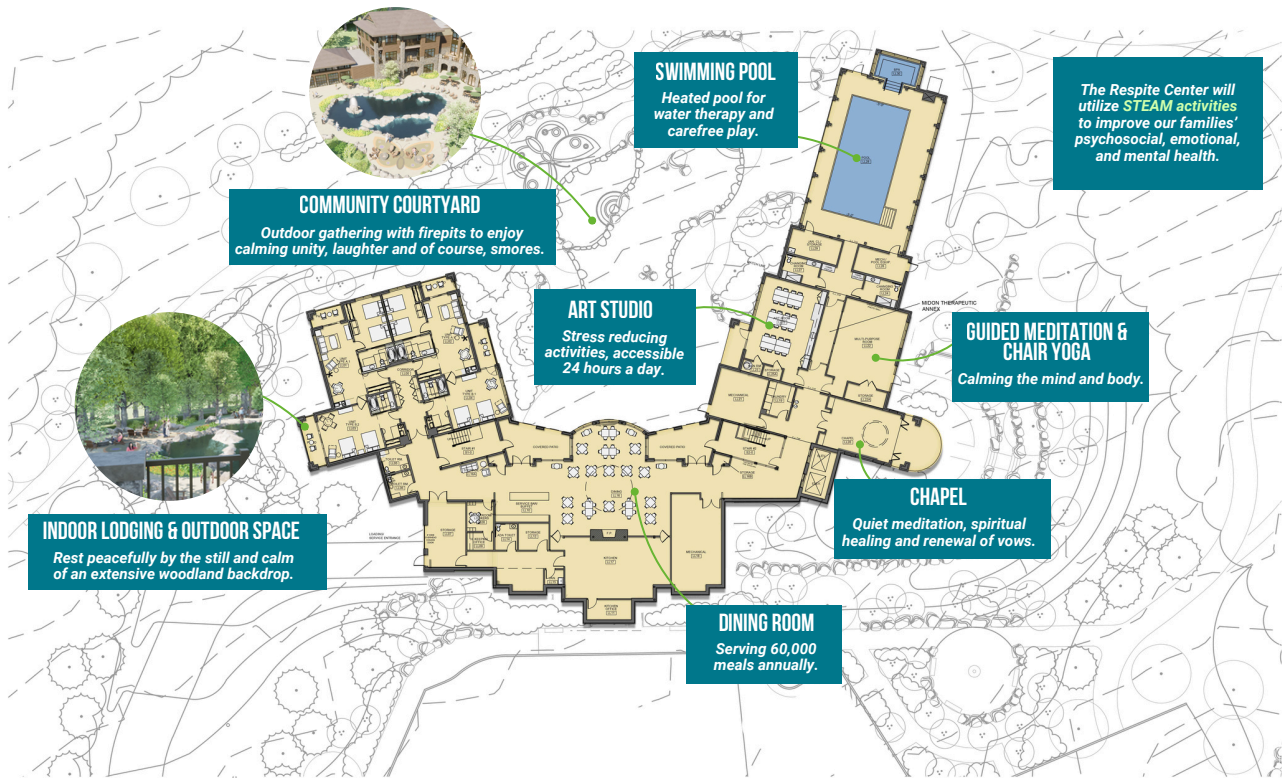
